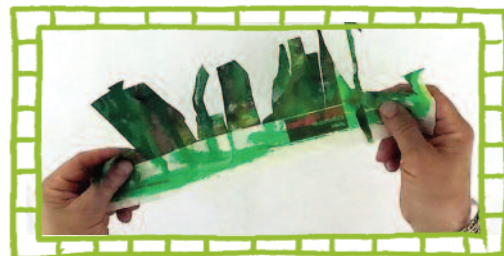
Make a Pond for your Duck



- 1 Colour a large piece of paper with lots of watery colours and shapes



- 2 Make 3 paper sticks by rolling a strip of paper around a pencil. Glue at the top corner to fix, then remove the pencil. Join together to make pond shape



- 4 Colour strips of paper green then cut or tear to make grass and reeds

- 3 Cut a circle to fit your pond fold over edges to stick to shape



- 5 Stick reeds to the water edge
