What to Expect During the Performance



This is a relaxed space.

It's okay to tic, stim, leave and come back, make noises, laugh or cry!



We have a few **ear defenders** that you can borrow. If you have your own, feel free to bring them \heartsuit



The whole experience lasts for 45 minutes.

There is **no interval**, but **you can leave at any moment** and **come back**.



There will be **gentle pulses or shifting lights**, in **different colours** like yellow, blue, green, red, purple or pink.



As you enter, there may be **music playing** from the **speakers**.


During the performance there will be **live and** recorded music, as well as **talking**, singing and joyful shouting.

There will be sounds coming from **guitars**, **drum pads** and other **musical instruments**, as well as sounds from **speakers**.



There will also be audience interaction.


Everyone is invited to **interact**, **sing**, **dance** and **play**. But you can participate, or not participate, in any way you choose. There is **no pressure**.



There will also be lots of **shapes**, **colours**, **sounds and textures**.

This includes **multi-sensory elements**, which means there will be things **to look at**, **listen to**, **and touch** during the show.

The Set: What does it look like?




The set was designed by **Studio Spranks.** Here are some of Jade's brilliant sketches.

There's a **big spaceship** in the middle with a hole cut out of the window.

There are **musical instruments and speakers** in front of the spaceship, to one side of the stage.

The set is made of wood, foam, and LED lights, with lots of space-related images.

It's painted in colours like **pink**, **purple**, **and blue**.



As we discover more about Leicester, **images** will be stuck to the spaceship.

These may include a duck, a heart, a Ferris wheel, some flags and flower garlands.

The 'Wonder Mic' has a smiley face on it and looks a bit like a robot.

The Performers & Costumes

There are **four performers** in the show, who are all part of the **Boogie Woogie Space Junk Band!**

There are three alien band members, called Bri, Gaz, and Roxanne, and their Space Roadie, called Dhugal (pronounced 'Doogul').

The performers talk, sing, dance, play music, and interact with the audience.

Costumes

The performers wear glittery costumes which have sequins, tinsel, silk, tulle/netting and pom poms all over.

The costumes are in **bright pastel colours** with **pink**, **purple and green**. Dhugal wears a similar costume, but in **black**.
